School based smoking prevention “Be smart – don’t start”

- all schools in Brandenburg class 4-6
- school classes win prizes, if no one starts smoking within 4 months
- weekly record of smoking behaviour

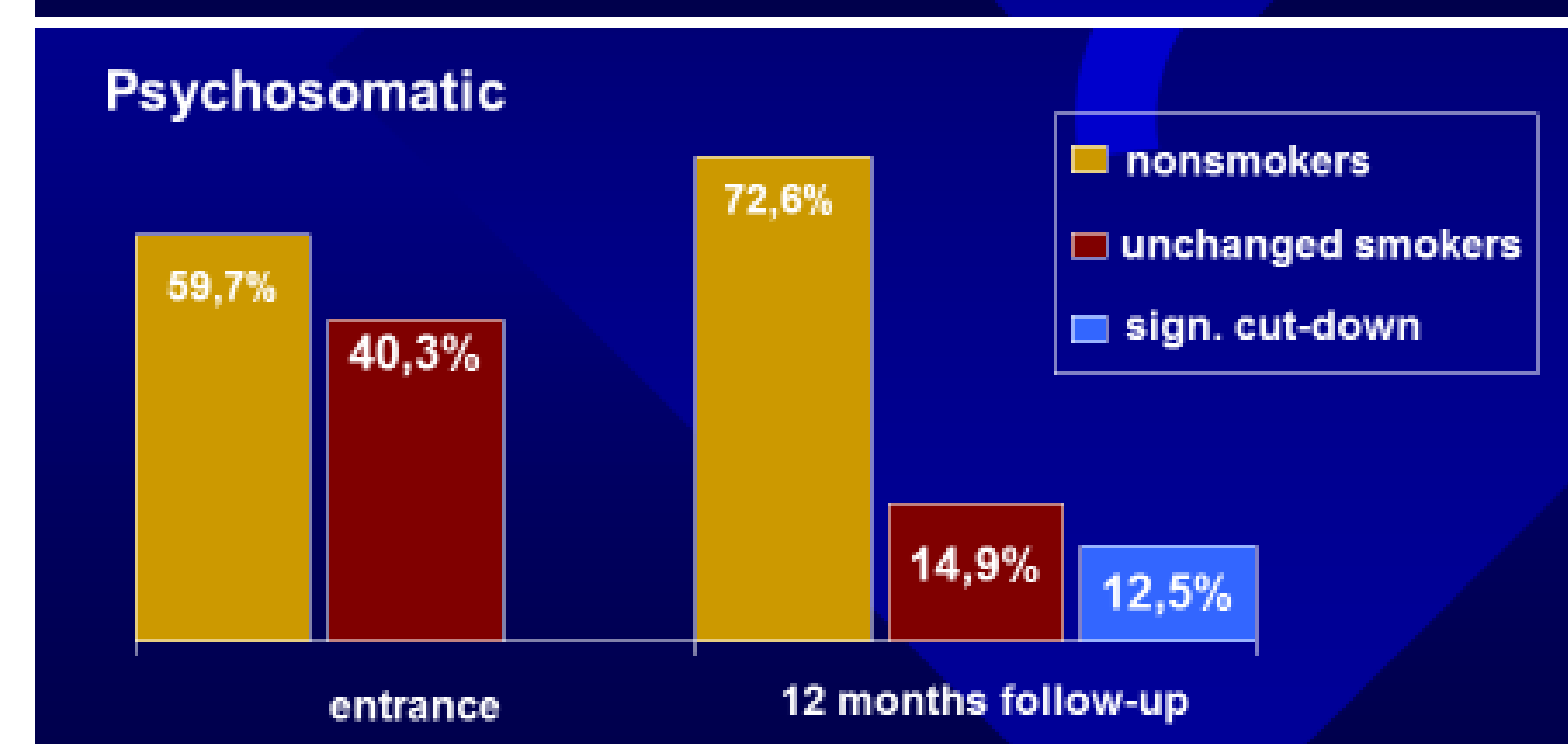
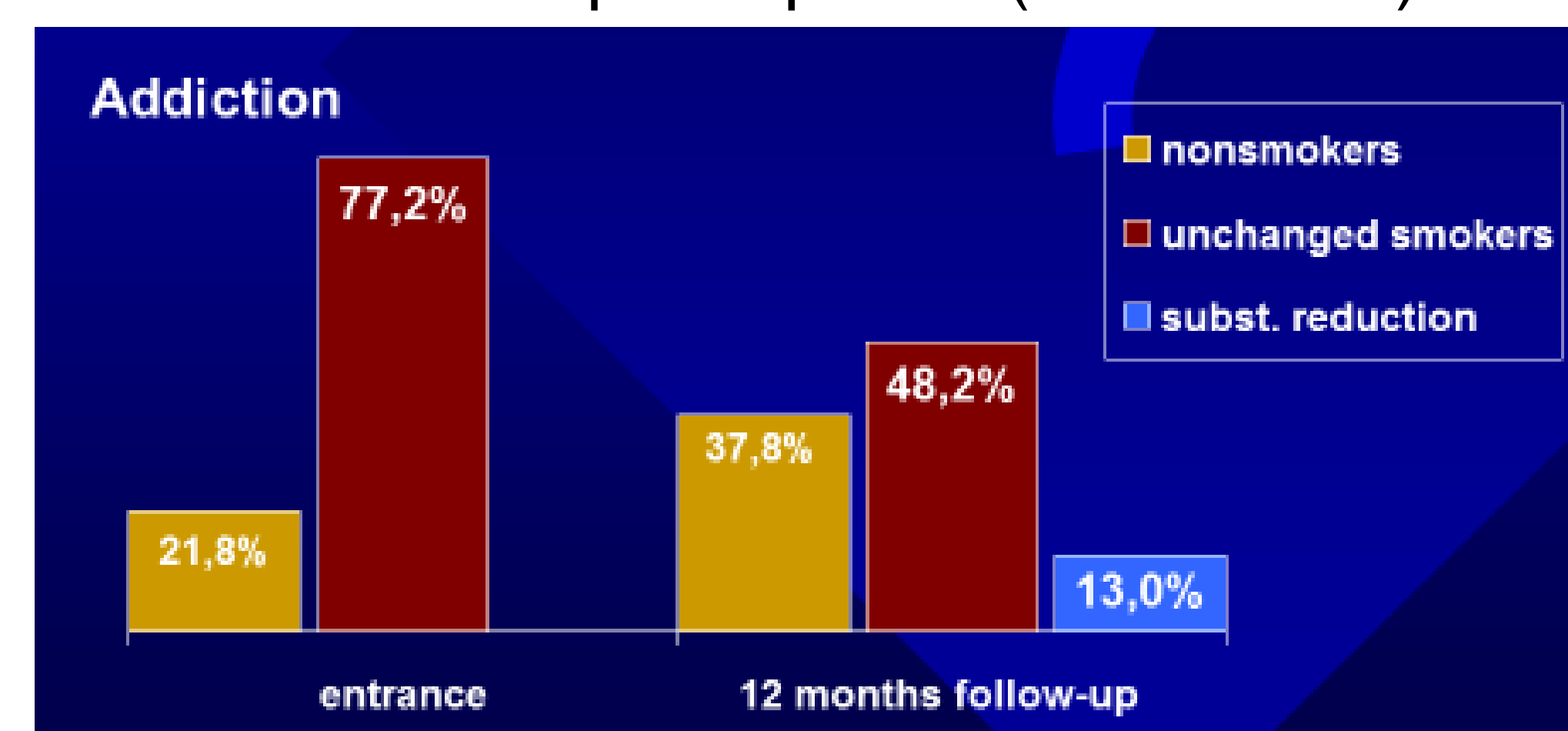
CBT – smoking cessation

- Computerized assessment of smoking status and behavior, medical check, CO-measurement, FNT belong to standard intake assessment of every patient
- Individual brief intervention (MI) depending on results with every smoker
- Lecture on CBT smoking cessation to every smoker
- 2 CBT smoking cessation groups with about 45,8/35,6% of smokers participating

4 steps treatment (5x 90 min / week)

- dealing with personal pros and cons
- preparing for day X
- NRT
- positive group-activities

- Free NRT for participants (60% use it)



E-Cigarette

- Clear standpoint with smoking cessation as primary goal without condemning e-cigarettes as a tool for harm reduction in the case of hard core smokers
- E-cigarettes allowed on campus outside smoking huts so that users don’t need to join smokers
- E-cigarettes banned indoors
- No selling of e-cigarettes in clinic shop
- < 1% use e-cigarettes during stay at clinic
