



WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?



Any healthcare services that fulfils the nomination criteria should be encouraged to participate

Candidate(s) must be nominated to the Global Network Coordinating Centre by an authorized submitter.

An authorised submitter is any one of the following:

- Lead or network coordinator of a member network
- Representative from a relevant national organisation involved in tobacco control (ie.HPH)
- Representative of a public health organisation (such as Public Health Department of the relevant territory)



Responsibilities

- Verifying and Validating high-level implementation is the responsibility of the national process
- Providing clear information and evidence that high-level implementation is and was found in place is the responsibility of the national submitter
- Understand the processes used and quality of the results achieved is the responsibility of the Jury Team
- Providing information on the processes used and quality of the results achieved is the responsibility of the nominated candidate



National/Regional Validation Processes

The Global Network defines an external national/regional process as:

"A process external to the healthcare service, carried out by experts in tobacco control, health promotion and/or service user quality and safety and are trained in the implementing the Global Standards and the self-audit tool."

Key aspects of the external process include:

- Review of documentation and data
- On-site visit and/or peer-review process

There should be an identified lead to oversee the process and act as the authorised submitter for nominations to the GOLD Process






Requirements for Nomination







- Self-Audit score of ≥ 126
 (Standards 1-8)
 High quality implementation is achieved in all key areas
- 2. High level implementation must have been verified and validated by an external national/regional process
- 3. Nomination is by an authorized submitter
- Submission of contact details for a key person within the nominated healthcare service
- Acceptance that application is peerreviewed by a Jury Team assigned within the GOLD Forum Process
- 6. Payment of application fee (500 euro)

FORM A: What is the purpose of it?



The Jury needs to understand

- 1. The national tobacco control situation, in general and that specific to healthcare services
- 2. How candidates were selected for nomination (i.e. self audit, other activities to find out high implementation level)
- 3. What is the validation process on national/regional level:
 - How is insight gained and evidence presented on the implementation process used by the candidate?
 - What other processes are used, how is the reliability of the evidence of the reported results verified?

FORM A: There are 3 Parts to FORM A



Part 1: National Tobacco Control -Information on the situation at the regional and/or national level.

Part 2: National/Regional Process - Measures and process used at the regional/national level to externally verify and validate the selfaudited high-level implementation

Part 3: **Nomination Form** - national submitter is responsible for outlining in this Part sufficient information to demonstrate that the nominated candidate has fulfilled the nomination criteria completely and what was found (briefly) in the national process to support their nomination for recognition.

Note: complete a separate Part 3 for each candidate(copy and paste). All nominated candidates must be included in the same FORM A, one below the other.

FORM B: What is its the purpose?

The nominated candidate has responsibility to outline in FORM B implemented good practice and measures proposed to sustain and improve quality implementation of the Global Standards into the future.

Provide structured information on the whole implementation process:

- ✓ Measures, sustainability and future plans
- ✓ Supportive evidence
- ✓ Comments of the national coordinator

- describe the national verification and validation process used "FORM A".
- information from the national process for each nominated candidate.

Documentation must be submitted by the authorised Submitter before the deadline to the Global Network Coordinating Center.

Nominations close in September with candidates confirmed for the GOLD Process 2018/19.

SUBMISSION: 01/9/2019 - 17/09/2018



October/December 2018 Decision Form A / Inviting Form B

- All accepted nominations will then be invited to submit" Form B" to provide additional data and to highlight innovative and good practice
- Form B can be completed with the support of the authorised Submitter
- National/Regional coordinators will be assigned to Jury Team(s) to examine candidates from other networks and not from their own
- Candidate application fee €500 is applied now
- Decision FORM A: 20/09/2018 07/11/2018
- > Submit FORM B: 11/11/2019 11/12/2018



December 2018 / March 2019 Examination of candidates by the Jury Teams

- ➤ The Jury Team assigned to accepted candidates will examine the candidate's FORM B to identify innovative and good practice for sharing
- All candidates are reviewed at a Jury meeting in February after which the final jury decision will then be announced
- ➤ Each candidate will receive a full feedback report FORM C and new GOLD Forum Members an invitation to participate at the GOLD Forum Event
- > Final Decision DEADLINE: 14/12/2018 20/02/2019
- > Return of the FORM C: 20/02/2019 03/03/2019

Nominated Candidates to the GOLD Process will be reviewed by a Jury Team

- Each Jury Team will be composed of 2 experts
- A Jury Trainee is possible in a (max 3) Jury Team
- Jury Members must agree to abide by the Global Network
 Code of Conduct and its requirement for disclosing real or
 perceived Conflicts of interest at all times

Jury Teams are formed from the Jury Panel and candidates are assigned by the GOLD Process Lead team.
