



STANDARD 1 - GOVERNANCE AND COMMITMENT


Example 1: Six taxi drivers assisted in the promotion of tobacco free policy.



Taxi drivers near the hospital were invited to be smoking cessation advocators, and non-smoking ideas were introduced to passengers on the way through oral persuasion and health promotion materials.




Example 2: The staff record the history of smoking for all patients, inclusive of exposing to second-hand smoke/ecigarette vapour.
